#### **GENERAL AND NEW BUSINESS**

- Transition to New Board. Younid Gordon will be installed at the next meeting.
- **ASMC Brochure.** Yoenid Gordon received hardcopies of ASMC Chapter brochures. <u>CLOSED</u>: Yoenid will place an order for brochures and will submit for reimbursement.
- Treasurer (Monica Rakes) No update provided. We still need confirmation for receipt of the \$1300 payment for NASCAR participation. <u>CLOSED</u>: Monica will with work Dee to determine honorary contributions for Mini-PDI speakers. The Board agreed to a \$20 donation for each of the presentations. <u>CLOSED</u>: Nisha will look into updating the SAM site and reach out to Monica for assistance as needed. This was something done by the previous Treasurer.

#### **COMMITTEE CHAIRS**

- Chapter Competition (Marina Goode) The chapter audit was submitted this past month. National ASMC rules for FY22-23 have not yet been published. <u>ACTION</u>: Once National ASMC rules for FY22-23 have been published, Yoenid will add a hyperlink on the chapter website that links to the National website for criteria/requirements for which the chapter is being evaluated. This will allow members to learn more on how they can contribute.
- **Programs** (Wanda West) Ms. Davis, National ASMC President, is also a SES in DFAS. We hope to have her provide training to the chapter when we confirm a date for her to speak to the general membership. <u>ACTION</u>: Send email to members soliciting potential speakers and topics from Subject Matter Experts within their organizations to try and create a speaker schedule for the year.
- Community Service (Cathy Dale) Feed the Hungry will be held October 29<sup>th</sup> and Cathy will work with Yoenid to create a flyer. At least 5 members need to support to earn chapter points.
